## CHANGE THE NAME OF A LEGACY APP

It is possible to change the name and the look of a legacy program that appears on the Start Menu. (A legacy program is one that was created prior to Windows 8.) Generally, only a limited number modern applications (one that was created since the introduction of Windows 8.0) can be renamed, or their icons be modified. Microsoft determines which files can be changed.

- 1. While on the Start Menu, right-click on any legacy program that you want to change and click *Open tile location*.
- 2. After the program's file opens in its hidden location, right-click on it and click *rename*.
- 3. To change the look of the icon, right-click on it, go to *properties*, click on *Change icon*, and choose from those available.
- 4. Click OK.
