

HOW TO CHANGE THE SIZE OF FONTS AND ICONS IN WINDOWS 10?

The Windows 10 operating system can run on PCs, laptops, notepads, and even mobile phones. However, to each device, the operating system possesses a specific font size and it's not perfect for every application. Fortunately, you can adjust the size of the screen content to suit your needs.

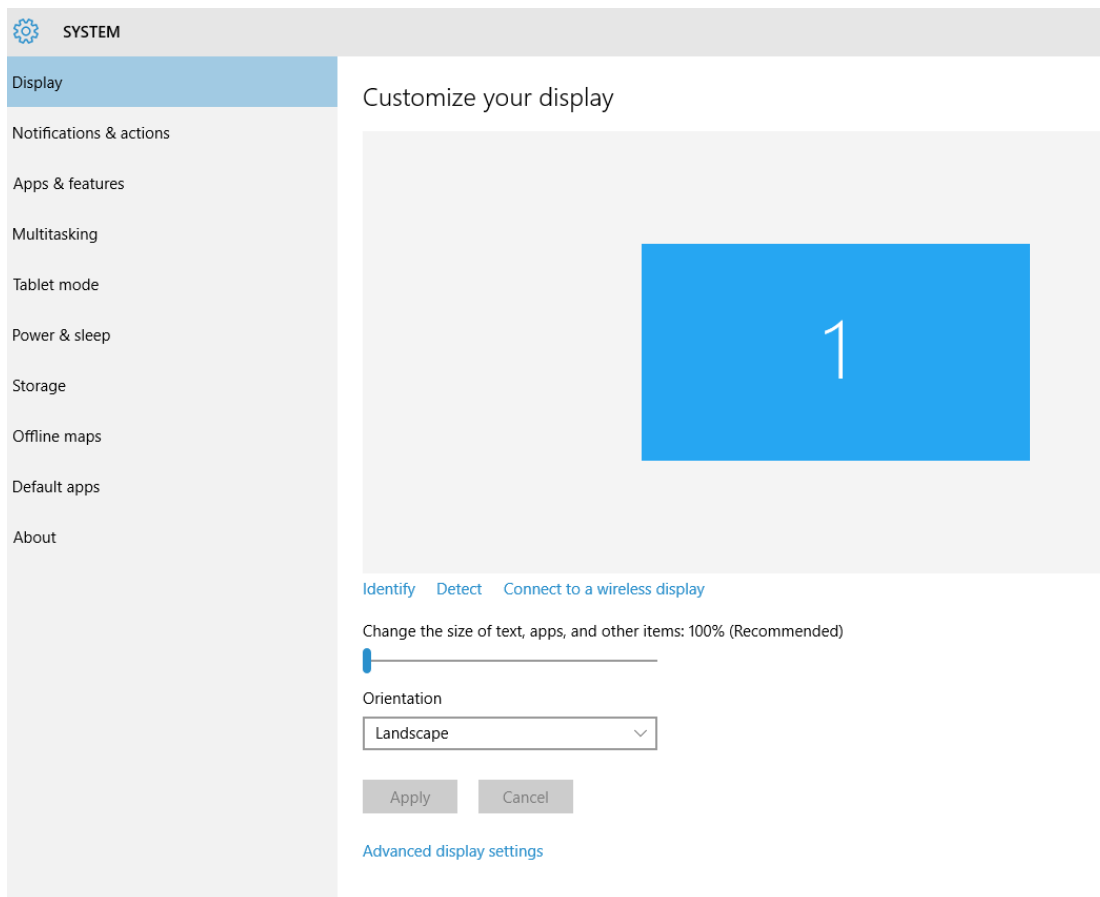
If you feel the displayed font size is too small or does not match the screen of the device you're using, you can customize the font size for the best fit.

Here's how.

Press the WinKey + I to display Settings.

Click on System.

Click on Display.



In the **Change the size of text, apps, and other items** box, move the lever to the right to create a size greater than 100%.

Once you change the size to over 100%, the following message will appear.
