HIDE THE TASK VIEW FROM THE TASKBAR

In Windows 10, there is a **Task View** button that provides an overview of all your open windows and virtual desktop features. When it is enabled, the Task View button will always appear to the immediate right of the search bar/icon.

This feature is enabled by default. If you'd like to disable it, perhaps to save space on your Taskbar, just right-click a blank area of the taskbar and deselect the *Show Taskview button*.

Many users prefer to use the Alt +Tab keys to move from one open window to the next.
