WINDOWS UPDATE IS GONE FROM CONTROL PANEL

Windows 8.1 offered two avenues for accessing Windows Update — one in PC Settings (Windows + I) and one in the older Control Panel. Windows 10 retains most of the old Control Panel, but the Windows Update interface has been removed.

Instead, you'll find Windows Update in the Settings app (Windows + I) under *Update & security*. This is the only interface for Windows Update in Windows 10. A shortcut for accessing Windows Update: Type **windows update** in the search box/icon that is located near the left corner of the Taskbar and then click on **Check for updates** that will appear at the top of the column.
