

HOW TO RESTORE MY COMPUTER* ICON TO THE DESKTOP

***also known as File Explorer**

Windows 10 improved upon its predecessors in a number of ways, but it changed a number of things that some users may have grown to rely upon. If you're one of those who miss the My Computer icon on the desktop, we've got a way to bring that old reliable button back. You can then rename the icon "File Explorer."

- 1) Right-click on the desktop and select *Personalize*.
- 2) From the left column, click *Themes*.
- 3) From the right column, click "Go to desktop icon settings."
- 4) Check the box next to Computer. (You can also check the boxes for Control Panel, Network and User's Files to bring those to the desktop.)
- 5) Click Apply.
- 6) Click OK.
- 7) Back at your Desktop, right-click on *This PC*.
- 8) Select Rename.
- 9) Type "File Explorer."
- 10) Click Enter.
