Turn on InPrivate Browsing

In addition to setting up a "throw-away email address, you may wish to turn on InPrivate Browsing in your browser. To activate it in Edge, simply click on the More tab (3 dots) in the upper right corner, and click on New InPrivate Window.

InPrivate Browsing helps prevent your browser from storing data about your browsing session. This includes cookies, temporary Internet files, history, and other data. Toolbars and extensions are disabled by default.

Turn on Tracking Protection

Tracking Protection helps you stay in control of your privacy as you browse the web. In Edge, click on the More tab (3 dots), move down to Advanced Settings, and then turn on Send do not track requests.
