

PERSONALIZE THE WINDOWS LOCK SCREEN

(THE LOCK SCREEN CAN BE BYPASSED BY NOT HAVING A LOGON PASSWORD FOR YOUR LOCAL ACCOUNT)

In Win10, the Lock screen can display the date and time, as well as notifications of new e-mail, calendar appointments, and other information. You can also add your own background picture to the Lock screen to give it a personal touch.

To personalize the Lock screen:

1. Press Windows + I, then *Personalization*.
2. Click on Lock Screen.
3. You may choose one of the generic images (picture) provided by Microsoft, or you can pick your own image, assuming you've downloaded photos or other images onto your PC. Click on the Browse button to view your local Pictures folder. Pick an image you like, and the Lock screen preview window changes to display your chosen image.

Where you could previously customize this screen with a single photo, in Windows 10 you can now configure a slide show consisting of photos that are in your picture folder. (Note: all pictures used in the slide show must be housed in the same folder.)
