

## **PIN FOLDERS TO THE START SCREEN**

Every app you install creates its own App screen tile. What's little known is the fact that you can pin *folders* to the Start screen and have them appear as tiles. Here's how.

Open *File Explorer* (**Windows + E**). Navigate to a folder that you want to pin to the Start screen, such as Documents. Right-click on that folder, and click on Pin to Start from the popup menu. (You can do the same for your Music folder, Pictures folder, or any of the other folders or nested folders in File Explorer.) Return to the Start screen, and scroll to the end. You'll see tiles for the various folders that you pinned.
