PIN A WEBSITE TO THE START SCREEN

You can pin a website to the Start Screen that's shown when you access the Start Menu. Once you pin a website, its shortcut appears as a tile in the Start Screen, as though it were an app. If you use a website often, having it on the Start Screen will save time.

To pin a website to the list of apps shown on the Start Screen, follow these steps:

- 1. Start Windows Edge (the browser).
- 2. In the Address bar, type the address of the web page that you want to pin; then press Enter. The web page is loaded in Edge.
- 3. Click the More button (3 horizontal dots) in the upper right corner, and then click *Pin this page to Start*.
- 4. When you return to the Start Menu, you will note that your target Webpage is located on the Start Screen as a tile.
