

QUICKLY DOWNLOAD UPDATES AND APPS FROM MULTIPLE SOURCES

You can now quickly download apps and updates from multiple sources. For example, you can download them from PCs on your local network as well as from PCs on the Internet. Here's how to configure this behavior:

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Click **Update & Security**.
3. In the list of settings that appears, click **Windows Update**. Windows Update is now shown on the screen.
4. Click **Advanced Options**.
5. In the list with advanced options, click Choose How Updates Are Delivered.
6. Set the *Download Windows Updates and Apps from Other PCs in Addition to Microsoft* switch to On.
7. Choose from the following sources for downloading apps and updates: • PCs on My Local Network • PCs on My Local Network, and PCs on the Internet.
8. Close Settings.
