

How to repair Modern applications

The Windows 10 operating system offers an easy way to **repair a Win10 app**, should it not function properly.

If there is some problem with any Modern app (one that was created specifically for Windows 8-10): When you click on it, you will find that it simply crashes and closes down, and you will be taken back to the start screen again.

This time, however, you will see a small 'x' sign on the bottom right corner of the App, indicating that something is wrong with this particular program.

Click on it again. This time, it will display a **This app can't open** message. To exit, you may click on Close. To repair it, you should click on the *Go to the Store* link.

You will now see a message stating that **This app needs to be repaired**.

Clicking on *Repair* will repair the app. The app is re-installed with all its default settings intact.

Once the app is repaired, you will see a notification in the top right side stating that the app was installed. (You will not be asked to pay for the installation; however, you may have to complete this procedure while you are in your Microsoft Account.)

Now if you try to open the app, you will see that it opens with appropriate updates.
