

## **RESIZE YOUR START SCREEN TILES FOR BETTER ORGANIZATION**

You'll notice that some of your Start screen tiles are rectangles while others are squares. You cannot adjust the size of a Start screen tile in the same way that you can a regular window, but you can switch certain tiles between large and small, rectangular and square.

Right-click on a Start screen tile. If the tile can be resized, you'll see an option on the drop down menu bar that says **Resize: small, medium, wide, and large**. Some tiles are limited in size to small and medium.

You may wish to use a big square for apps you really want to stand out and a tiny square that takes up just a quarter of the original square tile size, for those you hardly ever use. These choices should make the Start screen much easier to organize for optimal access. The new smallest size in particular means less scrolling through full-size tile pages. However, the smallest sized tiles do not have name tags. Only by hovering over a small tile will you be given the name of the application in question.
