

SUGGESTED ACTIONS IN WINDOWS 11

Windows 11 includes a new feature called Suggested actions that pop-ups when you copy a date, time, or phone number to the Clipboard and suggests relevant actions. For example, if you copy a date or time to the Clipboard, the Suggested action pop-up provides one or more “Create event” options so you can do so using a compatible app on your PC. And if you copy a phone number to the Clipboard, the Suggested action pop-up provides one or more “Call number” options so you can do that using a compatible app on your PC.

In addition to working only with this limited range of items, Suggested actions is only available in the U.S., Canada, and Mexico at this time. It is, at least, enabled by default. But if you would like to disable it, navigate to Settings > System > Clipboard and disable the setting “Suggested actions.”
