

# THE TASKBAR IS ALWAYS AVAILABLE— IT'S JUST OUT OF VIEW

The all-important Desktop Taskbar is always available, no matter what application or window you have open. Just move your mouse down towards the bottom of any maximized screen, and the Taskbar will appear!

If it is out of view, it means that you have checked the *Auto-hide the taskbar* checkbox in Taskbar properties. Find Taskbar properties by right-clicking on the Taskbar and then clicking *Taskbar Settings*. Turn off the *Automatically hide the taskbar in desktop mode*.
