

USE THE MONEY APP TO TRACK YOUR INVESTMENTS

You can use the Money app to read the latest financial news stories, see the latest financial data, and create a list of stocks to track. The app combines a wide variety of financial information in a single place. Its main screen — called Home — displays financial news; Dow statistics, NASDAQ information, and other index values; major stock activity; bond prices; interest rates; and more. You can also use the Money app to create a list — called a watchlist — of the stocks that you want to track.

1. Click Start.
2. Click Money.
3. To read the latest financial information, click a category. You can also scroll up, left, and down to see the latest financial news and data.
4. Click Menu.
5. Click Watchlist.
6. Click Add.
7. The Add to Watchlist screen appears.
8. Type the stock symbol or name of the stock that you want to add. As you type, Money displays stocks that match.
9. When you see the stock that you want, click it.
10. The Watchlist screen appears.

Is there a way to keep your watchlist on-screen so that you can monitor it? Yes, you can snap Money to the edge of the screen. In Money, display the Watchlist screen. Now press **+** to snap the window to the left side of the screen. If you prefer to snap the Money window to the right side, press and hold **+** and tap until the window is in the position you want.
