

UNINSTALL UNWANTED APPLICATIONS TO FREE UP DISK SPACE

You probably have several applications that appear in your All Apps menu that were placed there by either Microsoft or your hardware manufacturer that you know you will never use. If these unwanted applications appear on your Start screen or Taskbar, you can simply unpin them and they can be retrieved at a later date from All Apps. However, if these unwanted applications are cluttering up your All Apps menu and taking up room on your hard drive, you probably will want to do some housecleaning by uninstalling them.

You can uninstall them one at a time by right-clicking on each one and selecting *uninstall*. The option may be listed under more. Note that legacy programs must be uninstalled via Programs and Features (Winkey + X) and reinstalled via the Internet. Modern programs can be uninstalled via the All Apps menu and reinstalled via the Microsoft Store.

Another convenient method:

1. Type Winkey + I.
2. Click on Settings.
3. Click on System.
4. Click on Apps and Features.
5. There you will find dozens of apps that can be either moved or uninstalled.
