

Use the WinX Menu

In Windows 10, a hidden menu, the WinX menu, produces shortcuts to such useful tools and apps as Computer Management, the Control Panel, the Command Prompt, and the Task Manager. The menu's name comes from the keyboard shortcut that you press to open the menu: Windows+X.

You can also open the WinX menu with the mouse or by using touch:

- With a mouse, right-click the Windows logo on the taskbar.
- With a touch-sensitive screen, press and hold the Windows logo until the WinX menu appears. To start any of the tools available in the WinX menu, simply click or tap them.
