Using a Single Image on the Lock Screen

Do you have a particular wallpaper or image that you want to use on the Lock Screen? Windows 10 lets you set a single photo, which comes in really handy if you want an undistracted experience when you return from sleep mode.

Follow these steps to customize the Lock Screen to display a single image:

- 1. Go to Settings.
- 2. Click on **Personalization**.
- 3. Click on Lock screen.
- 4. Select the **Picture** option in the **Background** dropdown menu.
- 5. Click the **Browse** button below the thumbnails to locate the image you want to use, and then select it to set it as the new background.

Using an Image collection

Alternatively, if you have your own wallpaper collection, or a set of photos that you want displayed on the Lock Screen, you also have that option. Windows 10 lets you showcase a collection of images from one or multiple folders.

This is how you can display an image collection as a slideshow on the Lock Screen:

- 1. Open the **Settings**
- 2. Click on **Personalization**.
- 3. Click on Lock screen.
- 4. Use the **Background** dropdown menu to select the **Slideshow**
- 5. Select the **Pictures**
- 6. Click **Remove**.
- 7. Now, click on the **Add a folder** This option lets you add one or more folders that contain your chosen images.
- 8. Browse to the location of the folder with images that you want to showcase as a slideshow on the Lock Screen, and then select the folder.
- 9. Click the **Choose this folder**

This will set up a slideshow with the images you want on your Lock Screen.
