

When You Can't Find Your Mouse Pointer

When you need to click on something, but you can't find your mouse, it can be a major frustration. Despite moving that little critter all over your desk, your eye just can't seem to locate the pointer.

Here's a quick solution for you.

Right-click on **Start**, click on **Control Panel**, and click on **Mouse**. In the resulting window, click on the **Pointer Options** tab.

In the Visibility section, check **Show location of pointer when I press the CTRL key**. Finally, click OK and close any Windows.

From now on, when you press the CTRL key, a bullseye target to appear around the mouse cursor, even if it is hidden off the screen.
