

## **When Your Browser Prevents You from Viewing Up-to-Date Websites**

Although Edge saves, or caches, downloaded Web page data to decrease load times, any outdated content within the Web cache can prevent the browser from properly displaying Web pages that update frequently. To ensure that you have access to the latest version of a Web page, you must delete the contents within the Web cache.

While in Edge, click on the three dots near the upper right corner of the browser's window, move down and click on Settings. Then click on Clear Browsing Data. Finally, select Cached Data and Files, then Clear.

While in Edge, you can also use the Ctrl-Shift-Del shortcut to bring up the Clear Browsing Data column.
