

RENAME YOUR WINDOWS 11 PC

If you didn't create a name for your PC during the installation experience, Windows Setup will create a nonsense name—like DESKTOP-TAKKU2G or similar—for the PC instead. You should rename it now because you will see your PC's name referenced by OneDrive and other Microsoft services on the web and elsewhere.

1. To do so, right-click on the Start button (or press WINKEY + X) to display the Quick Access menu,
2. Choose “System” from the list.
3. In the System settings window that appears, select the “Rename this PC” button
4. Then enter a name that makes sense to you—perhaps Bills-Desktop or whatever. Sorry, you can't use spaces or most special characters in the PC name.
5. click Next.
6. You'll be told you have to reboot the PC. Do so.
