# HOW TO USE SNIPPING TOOL

You don't need a third-party application or your phone's camera to take screenshots. Windows 10 has an in-built feature known as **Snipping Tool**. Snipping Tool allows you to take a screenshot of the entire screen or snip a part of the screen, and then work on the captured image in an <u>image editor</u> or use it directly. It is a straightforward app that does not require much technical knowledge. You also have an option to email the captured image directly from the app's interface.

#### Launch Snipping Tool from Start Menu

- 1. Click Start Button
- 2. Scroll down to **Windows Accessories**, and under it, click on the **Snipping Tool**.

#### Launch Snipping Tool from The Run Window

- 1. Open Run Command Box (Windows key + R)
- 2. Type **snippingtool** and then hit Enter key or click on **OK**

#### **Open Snipping Tool using Windows Search**

On Windows Search bar type Snipping Tool and click on the suitable icon.

# Create a Keyboard Shortcut for Snipping Tool

- 1. Type Snipping Tools on Windows Search and open its location.
- 2. Right-click on its icon and choose Properties.
- 3. Under **Shortcut** choose Shortcut key of your choice

# Create a snipping icon on the Taskbar

- 1. Right-click on the Snipping Tool on the Menu.
- 2. Right-click on More, then click on Pin to Taskbar

# **How to Capture Screen Using Snipping Tool**

After opening the Snipping Tool, you are now ready to take a snip. Before that, you should know about the modes available to grab different types of snaps. Following types of modes are available:

- Free-form Snip: In this mode, you can freely pick the part of the screen you want to capture. Just roll-over the mouse pointer over the part you want to grab.
- Rectangular Snip: This mode allows you to take a rectangular shape snap.

- **Window Snip:** Using this mode, you can take the screenshot of an app window, such as a browser window or the dialog box.
- Full-screen Snip: Full-screen mode allows you to grab the snapshot of the entire screen

#### Steps to taking a Screenshot using Snipping Tool:

- 1. Open the Snipping Tool with your preferred way
- 2. Then, choose the snip mode according to the screenshot you want to take
- 3. Left-click and roll-over to the part you want to capture
- 4. Now the selected part can be saved to the tool's desktop for convenient temporary storage.
