Windows 10 automatically tracks your location and monitors your behavior in order to sell advertising. Here's how to turn both of those features off to better protect your <u>privacy</u>:

- 1. Go to Settings (Windows +I)
- 2. Click **Privacy**, the icon that looks like a padlock.
- 3. Click Location, then click the On switch to turn location tracking off.
- 4. To disable ad tracking: Go back to the **Privacy** screen you were just on.
- 6. Turn off the setting for Let apps use advertising ID to make ads more interesting to you based on your app activity.
